All four LMD museums will host a day dedicated to promoting STEM subjects and increasing science literacy. On this special day, visitors can purchase a \$10 ticket allowing them to visit and participate in MSF festivities at all four LMD museums. A free shuttle will be provided between museums and food vendors will be onsite throughout the day at all museums.
